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Digital SAT Prep 9-12 Syllabus



Course Goals

1 SAT Overview

Students learn about the format, question types, and content material covered by the SAT.

2 Digital Practice Tests

Students take multiple practice SAT tests under authentic conditions, using Bluebook which is the platform used to take the SAT on Test Day.

3 Test-Taking Strategies

Students learn valuable test-taking skills, such as how to use the test format to their advantage and how to maximize mental and physical readiness.

4 Goal Setting

Students create a personal study plan for themselves, and use the SAT grading scales to set detailed personal goals.

Course Topics

1 Information and Ideas

Students learn how to answer SAT questions pertaining to the central idea of a passage, details, and inferences that can be drawn. Students also work through passages that include graphs and tables.

2 Craft and Structure

Students practice questions involving words in context, the purpose of a text, and drawing connections between a pair of related texts.

3 Expression of Ideas

Students practice how to select proper transition words in passages and how to summarize information to fulfill a writing goal.

4 Standard English Conventions

Students learn how to edit passages to be grammatically correct through understanding how to separate independent clauses, how to use less common punctuation marks, and how to use verbs in the correct form and tense.

5 Algebra

Students review and practice questions that involve creating equations to represent situations, solving equations and systems of equations, and working with inequalities.

6 Advanced Math

Students review and practice SAT questions about quadratic and exponential functions, radicals, exponents, modeling growth and decay, and finding equivalent forms of expressions.

7 Problem-Solving and Data Analysis

Students practice SAT questions concerning rates, ratios, proportions, percentages, scatterplots, probability, and statistically analyzing the results of experiments.

8 Geometry and Trigonometry

Students practice SAT questions involving triangles, special right triangles, circles, surface area, volume, trigonometric ratios, and converting between degrees and radians.
