Course Goals

1 Writing Skills

Students learn to write well-organized, thoughtful multi-paragraph essays by using sentences as building blocks.

2 U.S. Presidents

Students learn about the lives and administrations of our presidents from George Washington to Franklin Delano Roosevelt.

Course Topics

1 Topic Sentences

Students use topic sentences to form the basis of paragraphs in written works.

2 Conjunctions

Students understand how to use basic and subordinating conjunctions to add variety and complexity to their sentences.

3 Paragraph Organization

Students learn how to organize paragraphs and provide suitable transitions between them.

4 Note-Taking

Students learn how to read complex material while taking notes to better understand the content.

5 Revision

Students become familiar with the writing process as they revise their essays using instructor feedback.

6 Presidential Administrations

Students understand the events surrounding past presidential administrations and how the actions taken back then have an impact on the present day.

7 Primary Sources

Students become familiar with reading and understanding primary sources from early American history.

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
